

Subject : Non-availability of drinking water and poor condition of Gate Lodge
Track maintainers put to severe hardships-reg.

Secretary, NFIR have sent representation to Secretary (E) on the above cited subject and mentioned that Zonal Railways have not taken measures for ensuring supply of drinking water to the track maintainers at work places i.e. at Railway tracks well as at level crossing gates. The gate lodges wherever available in very bad shape due to leakage of roof and cracked walls causing safety hazards to those track maintainers who man the gates. At some gate lodges, no power supply is ensured. The solar power supply lasts for a few hours consequently the Gate Keepers are compelled to perform duties in total darkness.

Railways are requested to ensure that drinking water is supplied uninterruptedly to the Track Maintainers as well as to the Gate Keepers, Gate lodges which are in bad shape to be repaired. It has also been requested to ensure uninterrupted power supply to Gate Lodge since Solar Power lasts for few hours and the Gate Keepers are compelled to work in total darkness.

Railways are requested to take necessary action.

Sub : Number of Gatekeepers and their working hours at level crossings.

NFIR has raised an issue relating to inadequate deployment of Gatekeepers at Level Crossing Gates (Engineering). They have contended that there has been manifold increase in the workload due to increase in number of trains. However, there has been no corresponding increase in the number of Gate Keepers for manning aforesaid gates. NFIR has, therefore, requested to conduct job analysis for deciding classification / duty hours of Gatekeepers.

2. The issue has been examined in the Board's office. It is observed that under Rule 3 of the "Railway Servants (Hours of Work & Period of Rest) Rules, 2005", the Head of the Railway Administration (or CPO, if delegated) is the prescribed authority to decide the classification / working hours of Railway servants. Accordingly Zonal Railways should conduct factual job analysis for deciding classification / duty hours of Gatekeepers if there is an administrative requirement keeping in view aforementioned demand of Federation, in terms of extant instructions and rules.
