Dear Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to NFIR's letter No. II/94/Part I dated 08.11.2019 on the above subject and to state that the demand raised in para (c) regarding non-consideration of Inter Railway Transfer request of Level -I safety category staff (Track Maintainers, Helpers etc.) due to non-availability of replacement has been examined by the competent authority.

Vide Board's letter dated 20.09.2019, Zonal Railways have been advised to forward the Inter Railway Transfers requests, where there is reasonable possibility of relief in case of acceptance by the Railway to which transfer is sought. While doing so, various factors like number of staff likely to be inducted in the cadre by way of Departmental Promotions/Inter-Divisional/Inter Railway Transfer from other Railways/Divisions and through RRB indents should be kept in view so that once NOC is received, the concerned employee can be relieved early.

NFIR may appreciate that extant instructions do not prohibit forwarding of application, but restrict the number that can be forwarded to them that are likely to get filled up through recruitment/promotion etc.
