The Railway Ministry has recently enhanced the recruitment qualification for appointment from Open Market to the posts in Level-1 of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC Pay Matrix (6<sup>th</sup> CPC GP 1800/-) to "10<sup>th</sup> Pass plus National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) granted by NCVT OR 10<sup>th</sup> Pass plus ITI" in Technical Departments (Civil Engineering, Mechanical, Electrical and S&T Departments). But however, no improvement of Pay Matrix Level has been done by the Railway Ministry, corresponding with the enhanced entry qualification.
