On NFIR/SRES persistent demand the Work Related Illness and Injury Leave (WRIL) has been introduced for the employees suffering with work related issues.

For eg. 1) The employees working in Diesel are suffering with Diesel allergic (skin diseases, breathing problem, etc).

2) The employees working in Welding section are suffering with eye problems, inhaling of welding fumes (OSH), etc.

3) C&W, TLD, AC, Traffic Yard Staff are suffering due to discharging of Bio-toilets and CDTs leaks into the examination pit lines, Stagnation of Algal sewage sludge, etc.

4) Track Machine Staff are suffering due to inhaling of severe dust, etc.

Those employees can avail WRIL as per the reply given to GS/NFIR by Rly. Board vide Lr. No. E(P&A)I-2021/FE-4/1 of 05.4.2021 and as per RBE 64/2019.
