Dear Sir,

The undersigned is directed to refer to the two Federations letters cited above and to state that the issues raised therein have been thoroughly examined in consultation with the Zonal Railways and it has been observed that there is no negative impact of the instructions contained in RBE No. 153/2019 on the inter Railway/ inter Divisional transfers as stated in the letters under reference.

In this regard, it is stated that as per the instructions of the Railway Board, inter railway transfers are being carried out by the Zonal Railways. The requests are considered based on priority and are further subject to safety/operational requirements. It is pertinent to mention that a total of 1788 employees have been relieved by the ECoR, SR, SCR, SWR on inter railway own request transfer basis in the last year alone. Further, South Western Railway have successfully relieved around 2000 employees to other railways in the past two years with no adverse impact. Similarly, ECoR is also following the Railway Board's instructions on inter railway transfers and is considering all applications while forwarding them to other railways. The number of staff likely to be inducted through promotions, Inter-Divisional/Inter-Railway transfers, and RRB indents are taken into account while forwarding transfer requests. South Central Railway have advised all their divisions to immediately relieve all employees on Inter Railway Mutual Transfer (IRMT) and Inter Railway Request Transfer (IRRT) as the railway is going to get employees in some critical categories. SCR has further advised the divisions for revalidation of NOCs for IRRT cases of Track Maintainers, ASMs and Train Managers.

Federations may kindly appreciate the position.
