- NFIR continuously pursuing through Railway Board PNM of Sub. No.11/2017 and also represented to Railway Board on 07.08.2017 for replacement of GP 1900 with GP 2000 and grant GP 4200 for Dresser Category.
- Board gave reply to GS/NFIR vide Lr. No. PC-VII/2016/R-U/35 dated 19.04.2018 as under to agree to process minimum GP 2000 and sent proposal to Finance Ministry on 12.04.2017.
- NFIR also pursuing maximum GP 4200.

Please refer to your letter dated 12.03.2018 seeking introduction of GP-4200/Level-6 in the category of Dressers/Operation Theatre Assistants (OTAs). The issue as represented earlier through letter No. IV/NFIR/7<sup>th</sup> CPC(Imp)/2016/R.B./Part I dated 07.08.2017 has already been considered and a reply to was also given vide Board's letter No. PC-VII/2016/R-U/35 dated 02.11.2017 (Annex-I).

- 2. With respect to present demand, it is pointed out that Ministry has already sought upgradation of Dresser-III from GP 1900 to GP 2000 in Railways on 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendation upgrading Dressers of MoH&FW from GP 1800 to GP 2000 through a reference to Ministry of Finance (Annexure-II). Subsequently a meeting has also been held with officials of Ministry of Finance on 21.02.2018 to expedite the approval of the proposal.
- 3. With regard to the present demand it is pointed out that even in CGHS, Dressers do not have GP of 4200, as observed by the Hon'ble CAT/PB in Para 11 of their judgement in OA No. 386 of 2012. The position has not changed after the implementation of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC recommendations.
- 4. Accordingly, it is requested that at this stage, it may be more appropriate to follow up on the upgradation of Dresser-III from GP 1900 to GP 2000/- on par with CGHS, rather than seek creation of upgraded grade pay of 4200/Level-6 for this cadre, which goes well beyond 7<sup>th</sup> CPC's recommendations in this respect.
