
Sub: Unjustified denial of two additional increments to the Nursing Staff possessing B.Sc. Nursing Degree-case of Southern Railway -regarding.

Please refer to Southern Railway's letter under reference on the above subject whereby it has been informed that after examining the case of 48 Staff Nurse, it was not found feasible to accept the request for grant of two additional increments as they were in possession of the qualification of B.Sc (Nursing) at the time of recruitment as Staff Nurse and B.Sc (Nursing) is also the prescribed basic qualification for the said post. However, as regards to the issue regarding admissibility/grant of the benefit of additional increments to Shri P. Ramesh Babu, S. Railway's reply is still silent.
