The issue raised in your above referred letter on the cited subject has been considered in Board's Office. It is reiterated that all the case details of the applicants under LARSGESS, their service records as well as the medical records are available with the concerned railway, for which reason, the Railways were directed vide Board's letter dated 12/07/2019 to examine & dispose of individual representations received for seeking employment under the LARSGESS Scheme prior to 27.10.2017, based on the factual matrix of the case.


The instructions issued vide Board's letter dated 12/07/2019 are clear and unambiguous. Zonal Railways are already examining and disposing of the pre-27.10.17 LARSGESS cases based on their factual matrix. It is reiterated that the decision taken by N F Railway, East Coast Railway and S C Railway are taken at the appropriate level on these Railways.
