In addition to the above, instructions for imparting training on First Aid, Medical Care & Trauma Management to raiway staff, involved in train operation(crew/Guard/SM/Controller/Gangmen/TTE/AC Staff) were issued vide 3oard's letter No.E(MPP)2010/3/65 dated 20.1.2012 (RBE No.11/2012), as part of the one day course on "Threat Perception and Emergency Response".

Railways are requested to ensure that the above instructions are fully implemented and all concerned staff are adequately trained in rendering First Aid at the time of their deployment at stations & trains.
