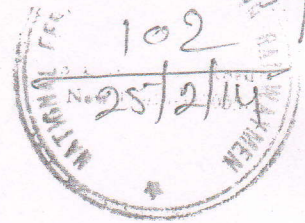

Sub:-Grant of financial upgradation under MACPS-treatment of employees
selected under LDCE/GDCE Scheme-clarification reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to NFIR's letter No.IV/MACPS/09/Pt.-7, dt. 23.12.2013 and to state that that Western Railway have stated that the post of J.E is to be filled up by 50% through RRB, 25% by promotion as per seniority and remaining 25% through LDCE and had sought as to whether the 25% through LDCE in JE to be considered as direct recruitment. Accordingly, WR has been replied vide Board's letter dt.13.12.2013.

Further, it is again reiterated that if the RRs prescribe for 'Promotion Quota' through LDCE/GDCE, such appointment would be treated as promotion for MACPS purpose. Evidently, an employee who has selected/promoted to a post having element of Promotion Quota cannot be treated at par with DR recruits under LDCE/GDCE. Moreover, the instructions on MACPS are based on DoP&T's directives, this Ministry is not in position to deviate from the instructions issued by them.
