Revision of age limit-reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to NFIR's letter No.IV/Committee(Trackmen)/2010/Pt.II dated 17.10.2012 on the above subject and to say that pursuant to a decision taken in a separate meeting of NFIR with Board(ME) held on 19.06.2012, instructions have been issued vide Board's letter No.E(NG)I-99/CFP/23 (Vol.II) dated 02.08.2012 reducing the lower age limit from 45 years to 40 years for the above purpose. The position is required to be reviewed after six months. Since six months are yet to be completed, the matter will be reviewed after 31.01.2013.
