1. APO examination (70%) was held on 27.04.2019 / 26.05.2019.
2. Result was published on 23.07.2019 vide under above reference.
3. Many candidates have submitted representation for irregularities on the evaluation.
4. 70% APO examination was held in the year 2016, 3 top candidates approached CAT - O.A. No. 1840/2017 and final hearing was fixed on 03.09.2019.
5. The present 70% APO selection result was published on 23.07.19 and the following candidates declared pass and the marks secured in the earlier examinations are furnished as under.
