**Sub : Selection for promotion from Group 'C' to Group 'B' service for the post of AMM in Stores Department against Regular Selection (70%).**

It is represented that AMM selection was notified vide under ref no. 1.

- Eligible list of candidates (seven names) to appear for the above examination was published vide under above ref. no.2
- Written examination was held on 24.11.2017.
- Four qualified candidates were called for Viva Voce vide under above ref. no.3.
- Two posting orders issued for selected candidates vide under ref. No. 4.
- Marks obtained by the candidates in written examination and viva voce published vide under ref. no.5 (after posting order mark list was published).

The following serious anomalies are brought to your kind notice for rectification.

1. Without publishing written examination and viva voce marks the selected candidates names were published vide ref. no.4.
2. The seniority should be determined as date of entry into the present grade. When all the selected candidates were entered on the same day, the seniority should have been taken based on the date of appointment / even if it alphabetical order Sri.Antony

Sebastian would have been first in the seniority list. (It should have been recast by date of appointment / alphabetical order).

3. It is very surprise to mention that after issuance of promotion posting order the marks obtained by the candidates in written examination and viva voce were published vide under above ref. no.5 (It never happened anywhere in Indian Railways).
4. Written examination marks and viva voce marks are as under :

It is crystal clear that the person who scored highest marks named Sri. Antony Sebastian was not selected. Person who scored less marks in written examination as well as viva voce were selected.

5. Out of the four candidates enlisted the candidate facing DAR enquiry (Shri. G.Bharathi) should have been kept out of the selection process. Whereas in this case the results were frozen and the enquiry was conducted and the penalty was served at lightning speed just to accommodate the person.

We therefore request you to kindly render the justice and honour the candidate who secured highest mark should be selected.
