Sub: Implementation of recommendations of 7th Central Pay Commission accepted by the Government – Payment of National Holiday Allowance to non-gazetted staff in Pay Level 9 and 10 on Indian Railways – reg.

Ref: (i) NFIR's letter No.I/5(g)/pt.VI dated 21/10/2017 to Railway Board.
(ii) NFIR's PNM item No.11/2018.
(iii) Record Note of Discussions dated 04/06/2019.

NFIR vide its PNM demand No.11/2018, had urged upon the Railway Board to take action for ensuring payment of National Holiday Allowance at revised rates to those Group 'C' employees who are in Level 9 and above (7th CPC). The subject was again discussed with EDPC-I on 04/06/2019 and during discussion, it was conveyed that the data from some of the Zonal Railways has not been received so far, in spite of reminders dated 19/06/2018 and 13/09/2018. It was however assured to the Federation that another reminder would be sent.

The Railway Board may kindly appreciate that this genuine matter is pending since the last more than one year, consequently the Group 'C' employees in Level 9 & 10 are extremely disappointed as they have not been made eligible for payment of National Holiday Allowance although they are entitled for NHA in terms of Railway Board's policy instructions contained in letter No. E(P&A)I-97/HL/2 dated 18/02/1998.

NFIR therefore urges upon the Railway Board to expedite the matter and issue orders for payment of NHA to those Group 'C' staff in Level 9 & above with retrospective effect, duly endorsing copy to the Federation.
