Sub: Revision of channels of Promotion (AVC) of non-gazetted staff of various categories – Medical Department-reg.

Ref: (i) Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)I/2017/PM 1/13 dated 22/10/2019 (RBE No. 178/2019).
(ii) NFIR's letter No. II/6/2019 dated 09/11/2019.

In continuation of NFIR's letter dated 09/11/2019, the Federation desires to convey that qualification prescribed for direct recruitment to the post of Radiographer (GP 2800+PB-1) in terms of Railway Board's instructions vide No. E(NG)II/99/RR1/97 dated 22/06/2001 (RBE, No. 119/2001) has not been finding place in the Board's letter vide RBE No. 178/2019 dated 22/10/2019. However extract of the said provision is mentioned below for incorporation in the revised AVC.

Educational Qualification for Direct Recruitment prescribed

"10+2 with Physics and Chemistry and Diploma in Radiography/ X-Ray Technician/ Radio diagnosis Technology (2years course) from recognized Institute. Science graduates with Diploma in Radiography/ X-Ray Technician /Radio diagnosis Technology (2 years course) shall be preferred."

Authority: Railway Board's letter No. E(NG)II/99/RR1/97 dated 22/06/2001.

NFIR, therefore, once again requests the Railway Board to kindly issue amended channel of promotion for the post of Radiographer on priority.

Action taken in the matter may kindly be conveyed to the Federation.
